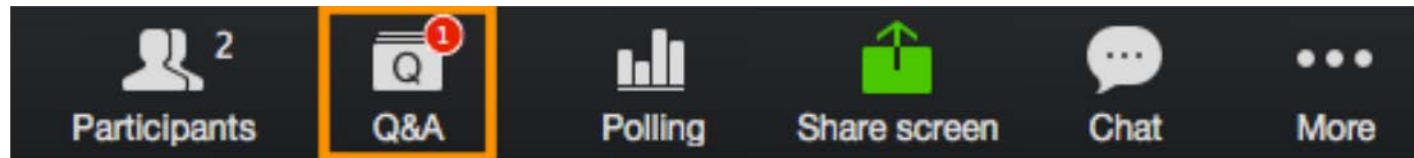

OUR GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be either a tax-exempt 501(c)(3) organization or sponsored by an eligible fiscal agent.
- Current and past grantees are not eligible to apply until their grant term has officially ended and a satisfactory final report has been received.
 - Example: If your organization was awarded a grant in Cycle 1, 2019 (June), your organization would not be eligible to apply until Cycle 2, 2020 (Sept. application/Dec. award).
- Your organization serves families and meets our eligibility requirements in one of our target communities.

WHERE WE FUND: OPEN TO PAST GRANTEEES ONLY

DC, NY, MD, & OH:

The Foundation will only accept proposals from past grantees* in Washington, DC (proper); New York City, NY; Anne Arundel County and Baltimore City, MD; and Cuyahoga County, OH.

*A past grantee is defined as an organization that has received a Responsive grant dating back to 2013, the year the Foundation shifted its funding priority to strengthening families.



WHERE WE FUND: OPEN TO NEW & PAST GRANTEEES

HI, FL, TX, VT:

The Foundation will accept proposals from new applicants and past grantees* in the Big Island, HI; Greater Orlando, FL; Harris, Montgomery and Waller counties, TX; and Bennington and Rutland counties, VT.

*A past grantee is defined as an organization that has received a Responsive grant dating back to 2013, the year the Foundation shifted its funding priority to strengthening families.



WHAT WE FUND: FAMILIES

- We support organizations that serve families, broadly defined.
- We are particularly interested in organizations implementing “whole-family” approaches that strive to meet the needs of the entire family unit – addressing the needs of both children and the adults in their lives together.



WHAT WE FUND

We support organizations that serve families, broadly defined, in the areas of:

- Health & Well Being
- Educational Success
- Homelessness

TYPE OF GRANT

GENERAL OPERATING SUPPORT (NEW)

- Awards may be used for general operations, programs and services, and/or capacity building needs
- Current board-approved strategic plan or business plan required at time of request
- Organizations may request no more than 10% of their total operating budget (up to \$50,000)
- Average grant size is \$25,000 to \$30,000
- 1-year grant term


- Strategic alignment with the Foundation's priorities

- Programmatic impact
- Community and constituent engagement
- Organizational and financial health
- Connection between your strategic priorities and family outcomes

WHAT WE CONSIDER

- Connection between your strategic priorities and family outcomes
 - ✓ Current organizational strategic or business plan
 - ✓ List 1 – 3 strategic priorities from your plan that you will undertake during the grant period
 - ✓ What results for families do you expect by addressing the strategic priority(ies)?

HOW TO APPLY

- Determine your organization's eligibility to apply by reviewing our website.
- If eligible, review the grant application template (available on our website).
- Log into the grants management system via the apply link on our website.
- Be sure to read log-in instructions.



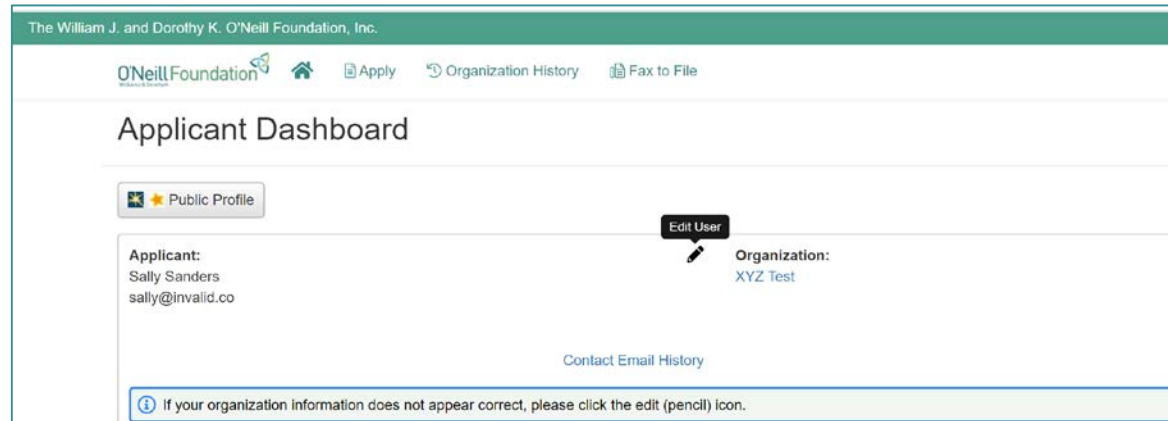

OUR REVIEW PROCESS

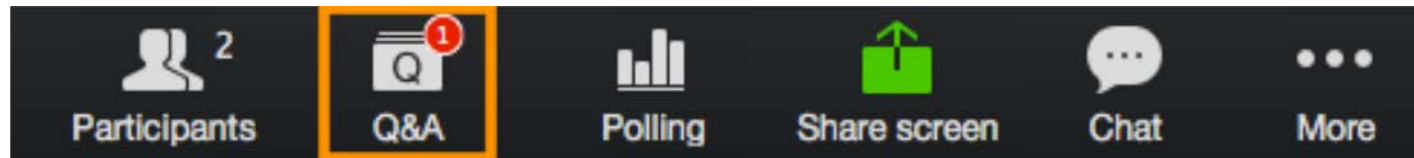
- Process is competitive
- Cycle 1 site visits will take place in April 2020
- June 22, 2020 Trustee meeting (award decision)
- Grant Agreements and ACH Payment Authorizations will need to be completed by authorized signors and submitted via our grants portal.
- Final narrative and budget reports due 30 days after 1-YR grant term ends
 - Note: Your organization will not be eligible for future funding until the grant term has fully expired and a satisfactory final report has been submitted. This means if you receive funding Cycle 1 2020, you would not be eligible until Cycle 2 2021.
